

REQUIREMENTS FOR GROUP VISITATION TO POSSUMWOOD ACRES WILDLIFE SANCTUARY

In order to ensure the best experience for your Group Visit to Possumwood Acres Wildlife Sanctuary the following requirements must be followed:

1. **WARNING: WE USE PEANUTS.** If you have a peanut allergy be aware that there are peanuts all over the outside of the property and inside the animal room. Since we feed them to our birds and squirrels and have peanut butter crackers inside our animal room for volunteer snacks, this makes PAWS dangerous for those with peanut allergies.
2. There will be total supervision of children by Camp Counselors, Teachers, Guardians and/or Group Leaders.
3. Each child must have a permission slip signed by his or her parent or legal guardian. Your Group should have its own liability insurance to cover any problems.
4. Children should wear closed shoes (no flip flops or sandals) and clothing appropriate for an outdoor experience where there is water and mud.
5. Visitors should have a current tetanus shot.
6. The Group will provide its own drinks and snacks if so desired
7. Rules and Regulations of Possumwood must be adhered to:
No running, yelling, or touching, chasing or feeding the animals.
8. A donation to Possumwood Acres Wildlife Sanctuary to cover our time and teaching /nature lesson presentation is expected. We accept donations of supplies, a list can be found on our web site or a monetary donation can be made.

We are sure that you understand that it is for the safety of both our visitors and our resident animals that we ask you to observe these requirements. We look forward to seeing you and hope that you will enjoy the experience of Possumwood Acres Wildlife Sanctuary.
